Choosing a new Minister: Sunday 19th July

After considering the positive reactions of members, the Vacancy Committee has on behalf of the Church asked *Rev Esther Mason to 'preach with a view' on Sunday 19th July. A Church Meeting will follow the service at which a vote of church members will be taken on whether to invite Esther to be our minister.* This service and the Church Meeting will be conducted using Zoom. For those who do not have easy access to Zoom, the service and Church Meeting will be streamed in the church on our big screen. We'll ensure those in the church building are able to make comments in the Church Meeting. NB Church attendance rules will be like those below.

Church Opening for Private Prayer and Reflection

The church is now open for *individuals* (not groups) for private prayer and reflection on Wednesdays from 10 am to 2 pm. We have to follow strict guidelines. This opening is for individuals, not for groups. It is for prayer and reflection: please chat outside the building (this is possible!). NB You will need to use hand gel on entry and exit, maintain social distancing, and bring any items you need for prayer (you may not use church hymn books or other items). The chairs do not have arms and are distanced by 2 m. You will need to sign in and out. Also, do not plan to be able to use the toilets!

Volunteer stewards are needed to help while the church is open. If you are willing to help for some time between 10 am and 2 pm on a Wednesday, please contact Margaret or Stella.
