Church Activities under new Rules

We hope to be able to **open the church building for services for those unable to use Zoom from** 6th December. Services will continue to be streamed on Zoom.

We hope to re-start <u>Meeting Place</u> in the Christ Church Rooms 10 am - noon from <u>Monday</u> 7th December and <u>Umbrella Coffee Club</u> outside Hobbs Bakery 10 am - noon from <u>Thursday</u> 10th December. All these re-starts depend on Government restrictions being lifted and will maintain Covid-19 safety requirements: look for further information after Thursday.

The *church is open for private prayer* on Wednesdays from 10 am to noon.

Christmas

Government rules allowing, we'll hold a *carol service in the church at 6 pm on Christmas Eve*. We'll use the balcony too, but numbers will still be restricted (the service will also be on Zoom). Admission to the church will be *only by booking places <u>before 17th December</u> (book through <i>Margaret*). Remember, there will be strict social distancing to keep people safe and no congregational singing in the church. There will be <u>coffee and mince pies</u> in the Christ Church *Rooms from 10 am to noon on <u>Christmas Day</u> for those otherwise on their own. There will be <u>no</u> service on Christmas Day or on 27th December.*

Please note that *Christmas cards <u>cannot</u> be delivered through church this year*.

Our usual *Christmas collection for charity* this year will be divided between our own new *Christ Church Help Fund* (for members of the congregation or local community in particular need during the pandemic) and *Christian Aid*. Donations may be posted through the church letterbox or sent electronically to the church account and marked as Christmas Collection.
