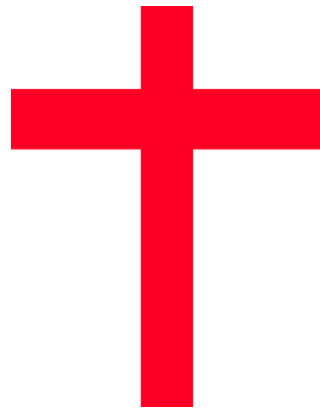


**Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2021**
